Patient Information Sheet Recommendations After Blood Collection

- 1. Leave dressing strip in place for 2 4 hours.
- 2. Avoid tight and restrictive clothing on the arm for about 24 hours.
- 3. Avoid activities which require active use of the arm for 24 hours, such as sports, digging, or carrying heavy parcels or a handbag.

Under normal circumstances, venepucture (drawing of blood) is a simple procedure that rarely causes any side effects. However mild discomfort, swelling or bruising may occur in some circumstances.

Should any of these symptoms occur, the following steps are recommended:

Bleeding at needle site:

- Apply firm pressure directly over the needle site and elevate the arm until bleeding stops.

Discomfort or swelling around needle site:

- Rest the arm, elevate and apply an ice pack to the site.

Excessive bruising:

- Rest the arm, elevate and apply an ice pack to the site and affected area.
