

# Medicare non-rebateable tests

February 2018

Although Medicare covers the cost of most pathology tests, there are specific tests that are excluded from this. Pathology tests that are not covered by Medicare, do not have a Medicare item number are known as a non-rebateable test.

The following list is subject to change as Medicare non-rebateable tests are performed by external reference laboratories.
